



Promotion Criteria for Cool Tennis Players



Red Ball

- Level I to Achiever – 9 matches played 2 wins
- Achiever to Pro – 12 matches played 3 won
- Pro – 9 matches and 3 wins
- Playing Red Ball and Orange Ball – The players have to complete 9 matches and have to have 3 wins in Red Ball Pro Category. Once playing the Orange Category the player could play only 2 tournaments in Red Ball Category.
- If a player has completed the Pro category requirement that player would receive a merit certificate from SLTA as of completing the Red Ball category. If a coach recommends a player to directly start from the Achiever category, he should complete a minimum of 25 matches and 6 wins in both the Achiever and Pro categories. No player would be allowed to directly start from the PRO category



Promotion Criteria for Cool Tennis Players



Orange Ball

- Level I to Achiever – 9 matches played 2 wins
- Achiever to Pro - 12 matches played 3 won
- Pro – 9 matches and 3 wins
- Playing Orange Ball and Green Ball – The players have to complete 9 matches and have to have 3 wins in Orange Ball Pro Category. Once playing the Green Category the player could play only 2 tournaments in Orange Ball Category
- If a player has completed the Pro category requirement that player would receive a merit certificate from SLTA as of completing the Orange Ball category. If a coach recommends a player to directly start from the Achiever category, he should complete a minimum of 25 matches and 6 wins in both the Achiever and Pro categories. No player would be allowed to directly start from the PRO category.



Promotion Criteria for Cool Tennis Players



Green Ball

- Level I to Achiever – 12 matches played
- Achiever to Pro – 15 matches played 5 won
- Pro – 12 matches played 6 won
- If a player has completed the Pro category requirement that player would receive a merit certificate from SLTA as of completing the Green Ball category. If a coach recommends a player to directly start from Achiever category, he should complete minimum of 35 matches and 10 wins in both Achiever and Pro category. No player would be allowed to directly start from PRO category.
